- **What:**

- 3v3 is a small sided, but fast paced game. Games will be played on a gym floor with a futsal ball in 31x17 yard area with participants wearing tennis shoes or indoor flat soccer shoes. Games will be 18 minutes long with teams guaranteed 3 games plus possible playoff and group winner games for teams advancing out of group play. Each team must have a minimum of 4 players and maximum of 6.

I understand that participation in this sports program could result in injury and I do hereby release on behalf of myself and my dependent, Spring Arbor University, US Club Soccer, USYSA, USSF and its affiliated organizations, City of Jackson, City of Spring Arbor, the coaches, referees, and any other individuals or agencies connected in any way with the 3v3 tournament and Spring Arbor Soccer Program from any liability. As the parent or legal guardian of the above-named player, I hereby give my consent for emergency care prescribed by a duly licensed Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Dentistry. This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life, limb, or well-being of my dependent.

3v3 Rules:

Game Length: 18 minutes, running clock

Games: Each team will play a minimum of 3 games with top teams from groups advancing to playoff rounds.

Field Information: 94 feet long x 50 feet wide (31.3yds x 16.7 yds), dimensions of a basketball court. Half line marked 47 ft from each endline with a 3x3 ft goal marked outline around each goal. Players are not allowed to enter the goal box. Goal size is 3.5 feet high by 6 feet wide.

Number of Players: Each team must have a minimum of four players with maximum of six players. Players must wear same color shirts and socks. Substitutes will be placed on the sideline.

Substitutions: Players can be substituted at any stoppage. Players being substituted out of the game, must run/jog off. Players entering the game will wait at the half line.

Goalkeeper: There are NO goalkeepers. Players are not allowed to enter the goal box.

Goal-Box: If a defender touches the ball in the Goal-Box, a goal is awarded to the opposing team and the play restarts with at the half-line with a kickoff. If an attacker touches the ball in the Goal-Box, the defending team is awarded a goal kick. If the attacker scores a goal while in the Goal-Box, the goal is disallowed and play is restarted with a goal kick. If the ball is "dead," stops rolling, in the Goal-Box, a goal Kick is awarded to the defending team.

Goal Kicks: Must be taken from the endline line, maximum of three yards from the goal. Opponents must be at least 6 yards from the endline.

Corner Kicks: Taken from within 1 yard of the corner.

Kick-Ins: Balls will be kicked in from sideline instead of thrown in.

Slide Tackling: NOT allowed. Play restarts from a free kick at spot of slide tackle to opposing team.

Free Kicks: Opposing Teams must allow five yards from Goal-Kick. All free kicks and restarts are INDIRECT, must touch another player other than kicker before going in the goal. If free kick/foul awarded within 5 yards of Goal-Box, free kick will be placed 5 yards from the Goal-Box.

Penalty Kicks: Will be taken from the half-way line for Under 12 Divisions and lower and Endline for U14 Divisions and higher, is a direct kick, and without opponents impeding. All players must stand behind the half-line/off the field on a penalty kick.

Handball: Deliberately handling the ball that denies the opponent a clear goal scoring opportunity, will be restarted from a penalty kick. A handball that does not deny an obvious goal scoring opportunity will be a free kick for the opponent and is an indirect kick.

Offsides: There are no offsides

Half-Line Rule: Teams may only score in their Attacking Half of the field. If a goal is scored from the defending half of the field, the opponent is rewarded with a goal-kick.

Ejections: Referees have the right to eject players from the game for continual disobedience or breaking of the rules. If a player is sent off, he/she must sit out the remainder of that game plus the next game.

Scoring System (Group Play): Win=3 points, Tie=1 point Loss=0 points

Tiebreakers:

1. Head to head result
2. Goal differential
3. Golden Goal penalty shootout

Tiebreaker in Playoff Rounds: If game is tied at the end of regulation, teams will play a 5 minute golden-goal overtime period, first team to score wins. If play is tied at the end of the overtime period, game will move to golden goal shootout round. Teams will take penalty kick in each round, in a round each team is awarded one shooter, until one team makes and one team misses a penalty shot.

Sportsmanship: 3v3 Futsal is meant to be a fun, fast paced, and exciting game. We ask that you enjoy your experience and be a positive influence. Unsportsmanlike behavior from players and spectators will not be tolerated!

Team Contact: Each team must have a Team Contact. All information about the tournament will be communicated to the Team Contact Person for each team.

Referees: Will be Spring Arbor University Men's Soccer Players.

Proceeds: Will go directly to the Spring Arbor University Men's Soccer Program

Men's Soccer 3v3 Games: Scheduled will be 2-4 3v3 games among current Spring Arbor University Players. Players are welcome to attend and watch the games as a showcase opportunity.
